

# Charlotte Kay Wade

July 22, 1949 - November 10, 2016

Charlotte K. Wade, 67, of Smithfield, Pa., died unexpectedly Thursday, November 10, 2016, at the Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown. Born July 22, 1949 in Fairmont, W.Va., she was the daughter of Mary Jo (Ballah) Prickett of Laurel Point, W.Va., and the late Robert Prickett.

A 1967 graduate of University High School and a 1986 graduate of West Virginia University, she worked for a number of years at both the University and Monongalia General Hospitals, as an EEG Technician, Nurse's Aide, and later as a Critical Care and Psychiatric Nurse. Charlotte developed and taught the Medical Assistant Program at West Virginia Career College and West Virginia Career Institute, and was also a substitute teacher in Greene County. She was a member of the Sigma Theta Tau Nursing Sorority and encouraged many by volunteering in various churches and her local community.
