Albert S. Hall, 95 of Point Marion, died Tuesday, August 16, 2011 in the Point Manor Personal Care Home, where he had resided for the past seven years. Born March 30, 1916 in Isabelle, Pa., he was a son of the late Sid and Almadell Gray Hall. In 1942, he moved to Lake Lynn, raising his family there while working in the Maintenance Department of the Lake Lynn Power Station for 44 years. He was a member of 70 years at the Point Marion United Methodist Church. teaching all his family to do the same. He was a wonderful husband and very devoted father. He and the mother of their children gave as much love and TLC as could be given along with as much fun and togetherness as a family could ask for.
