Albert H. Jordan, Sr., 65, of Dilliner, Pa., and Palmyra, Virginia, died Tuesday, March 23, 2010 in the University of Virginia Medical Center, Charlottesville, Virginia, following a brief, but severe, bout with cancer. Born in Dilliner on Dec. 4, 1944, he was a son of the late Harry Jordan, Sr. and Helen Kushner Jordan. A graduate of Mapletown High School, he worked for a while in the coal mines, and later was a self employed contractor in home construction.
