Alex Fominko, Sr., 87, of Jane Lew, went to be with his Lord on Friday, August 28, 2015 at his home. Born in Granville, W.Va. on Feb. 7, 1928, he was a son of the late Julia (Kovach) and Tony Fominko, Sr.

He, along with his wife, owned and operated Fominko's General Store and Restaurant in Burnsville for many years.
