Anna Mae (Travis) Weber, 81, of Morgantown, W.Va., a native of Point Marion, Pa., passed on to her eternal reward on Tuesday, July 1, 2025. Born in Point Marion on Nov. 5, 1943, she was a daughter of the late Gladys (Menear) and Grover Cleveland Travis.
