Archibald “Kip” Fernand Rose, II, age 69, of Dilliner, Pa., passed away Saturday, July 18, 2020, at his home following a lengthy illness, with his loving family at his side. Born in Morgantown, W.Va. on August 27, 1950, he was a son of the late Madge (Grow) and Archibald F. Rose, I.
