Arthur F. "Art" Pritts, 92, of Aiken, South Carolina, and formerly of the Greensboro and Carmichaels, Pa. areas, died Wednesday, December 5, 2012, in Aiken at the Unihealth of Aiken Hospice. Born August 19, 1920 in Uniontown, Pa., he was a son of the late Arthur and Edna Pearl Pritts Haney. A graduate of Mapletown High School, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII. Art had a varied career over the years, from working as a deck hand on the tow boats, to serving as a fireman for a rubber plant in Ohio, and finally owning and operating, along with his wife, the Country Kitchen at Sugar Grove in Greensboro.
