



Arthur R. "Lefty" Stewart

February 8, 1929 - February 11, 2017

Arthur Raymond "Lefty" Stewart, 88, a longtime resident of Point Marion, Pa., passed away unexpectedly Saturday, February 11, 2017, at the Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown. Born in Point Marion on Feb. 8, 1929, he was a son of the late Edward Morgan and Manella Mae (Pounds) Stewart.
