



Arthur J. Strimel

July 28, 1941 - January 25, 2024

Arthur J. Strimel, 82, formerly of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Thursday, January 25, 2024, in North Royalton, Ohio, following a lengthy illness. He was born July 28, 1941, in Point Marion in the house in which he lived his entire life, until illness caused him to move near his daughter in Ohio. He was the son of the late Dorothy (Wisden) Dufour and Oscar Strimel.

A 1959 graduate of Point Marion High School, he owned and operated Art's Auto Parts in Point Marion for 44 years. Over the years, Art was active in the Point Marion Volunteer Fire Department, serving as Fire Chief, President, paramedic and EMS Director. He was head of the firemen's volunteer ambulance service for over 50 years, and ran countless emergency trips helping residents in the service area.

In his later years, Art was elected as Mayor of Point Marion, and then served as Point Marion Borough Manager and Treasurer, and was the "go to" man whenever there was a problem or issue within the borough. He was also an active and faithful member of the Redeemed Baptist Church in Point Marion. Surviving is his wife of 59 years, Linda (Morgart) Strimel; a daughter, Annetta Paszt and husband Kevin of North Royalton, Ohio; one grandson, Toby Paszt; his brother, Ralph Strimel and his wife Audrey of Gans, Pa.; several nieces and nephews; his fellow firemen all over Fayette County, as well as many friends in the Point Marion area.

Also deceased is a sister, Donna Hegedis.
