



## Arthur "Butch" Swearingen

Arthur "Butch" Swearingen, 76, of Dilliner, Pa., died Monday, October 19, 2020, at his home, following a lengthy illness. Born in Morgantown, WV on May 28, 1944, he was a son of the late Owen Lee and Juanita Ruth (Hoard) Swearingen.
