Barbara Sue Greenwood, 69, of Fairmont, W.Va., and a former longtime resident of Greene County, passed away Sunday, November 14, 2021, in the Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, following a brief illness. Born Dec. 29, 1951 in Waynesburg, she was a daughter of the late James A. and Ruth (King) Greenwood.
