



Benny P. Crimbly

March 9, 1922 - August 16, 2011

Benny P. Crimbly, Sr., 89, of Point Marion, Pa., died Saturday, August 13, 2011, at his home with his family at his side. Born March 9, 1922 in Greensburg, Pa., he was a son of the late Eugene and Felicia Elenteri Crimbly. He was a faithful member of the Point Marion United Methodist Church. A U.S. Army veteran of WWII, he served in the 4th Armored Division in Europe under General Patton, and received two Purple Heart Medals. Ben was chairman of the Fayette County Vocational-Technical School Building Authority, and had previously served on the Albert Gallatin School Board and the Albert Gallatin Water Authority Board. For 63 years, he owned and operated Crimbly Trucking in Point Marion, along with his wife and son. He was predeceased by his son, Ben Crimbly, Jr. and daughter, Suzanna F. Crimbly. Surviving is his wife of 68 years, Mary Butterworth Crimbly; his daughter-in-law, Sandy Crimbly; three grandchildren and their spouses, Barbara and Dean Vance, Tonya and Allan Cottrell and Danielle and Wesley Sicina, all of the Point Marion area; six great-grandchildren, Leah Hall and her fiancé Ross Myers, Ashley Cottrell and her friend Nick Marella, A.J. and John Cottrell, and Kylie and Payten Sicina; and three brothers, Philip, Eugene and Alfred Crimboli, all of Greensburg. Friends will be received in the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, Point Marion, Pa. on Monday 3 - 5 and 7 - 9 p.m., and Tuesday until from 10 - 10:45 a.m. Funeral services will begin in the Point Marion United Methodist Church at 11:00 a.m., with Rev. Jay Polowsky officiating. Interment follows in the Evergreen Memorial Park, Point Marion,
