Carl H. Moats, Sr., 72, of Lake Lynn, Pa., died Tuesday, April 8, 2014, at the Ruby Memorial Hospital. Born in Lake Lynn, Pa. on Jan. 11, 1942 in the home in which he was currently residing, he was a son of the late Lloyd and Marie (Clark) Moats.
