Charles A. Bane, 88, a longtime resident of New Geneva, Pa., passed away quietly at his home on Tuesday, March 27, 2012, following a lengthy illness. Born March 8, 1924 in Clarksville, Pa., he was a son of the late Clarence and Leona Bowser Bane. A member of the First Baptist Church of Point Marion, he was a coal miner, retired, after 40 years in the mines, from Duquesne Light in Greensboro. Charles was a sergeant in the U.S. Army during WWII, where he served as a medic.
