Referred to fondly by many as CharBar, he was the kid everyone wanted on their team, the friend everyone wanted in their circle and the relative everyone wanted to claim as part of their family. He worked his last day at University Foodland in 1973, which was Norma's first day and so the story began. He worked at Quality Glass, Consol Humphrey #7 for 23 years and presently is employed with J.W. Ruby Memorial Hospital as an IT specialist. You would always find Charlie with a smile topped off with an Ivy

cap on his head, willing to be a helpful hand, always saying a kind word, embracing you with a warm hug and something to share that would make you laugh. It was a basic recipe for love. Speaking of recipes he loved to cook and had about 1000 recipes he wanted to try and post on Facebook. He liked to hunt, fish, travel and take pictures of all of the above. He often would say he was so grateful for the love and devotion from his family and friends and their reply was always the same... "You Charlie Barry are easy to love"!
