September 26, 1943 - January 15, 2016

Charles H. “Chuck” Rosnick, 72, a longtime resident of Point Marion, passed away suddenly Friday, January 15, 2016, at the Monongalia General Hospital in Morgantown. Born in Point Marion on Sept. 26, 1943, he was a son of the late John S. Rosnick and Anna (Trunzer) Rosnick Brewer.

Chuck proudly served in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam Conflict, and was a recipient of the Purple Heart Medal. He was a member of the American Legion Post 499 and the V.F.W. Post 747, both in Point Marion. For many years, he was active in the Point Marion business community, owning and operating Rosnick’s Auto Repair and Rosnick’s Collision Parts, and always willing to help anyone in need.
