Charles E. Sicina, 85, of Point Marion, Pa., died Sunday, May 11, 2025, following a lengthy illness. Born in Uniontown, Pa. on Feb. 18, 1940, he was a son of the late Marguerite and Tony Yanik.

A graduate of South Union Township High School, Chuck retired after 33 years with the Physics Department of West Virginia University where he was a lab instrument specialist. Before that, he had worked for Clar-Mac Sales in Point Marion. Chuck could fix or repair just about anything.

He was very active in the Point Marion community, having served for many years with the Volunteer Fire Department and as a paramedic in the Ambulance Corps. Chuck was a member of the F.O.E. #1932, the former Point Marion Lions Club, and the F & AM Valley Lodge, 459 in Masontown. He was also active in the Fayette County Chapter of the Penna. Fire Warden Association. In his spare time, he enjoyed gardening, and playing his bass guitar with several groups in the local area.

His wife of 62 years, Bonnie Sicina, passed away on May 22, 2024. Also deceased is a son, Christopher C. Sicina, on Nov. 22, 2021.

Surviving is his son Wesley Sicina and his wife Danielle of Smithfield; two granddaughters, Kylie Yanowsky and husband Richard and Payton Sicina,

two great-granddaughters, Leikan and Leila Yanowsky, and a brother, Ronald Sicina and wife Sallie Ann of Winslow, Maine.

A reception for family and friends will be held in the fire department social hall during the visitation break.
