Craig Allen Edmond, 52, of Morgantown, WV, passed away Monday, December 12, 2016, after a prolonged and courageous battle with cancer.

Craig was a devoted fire fighter, serving his community for many years with both the Cheat Lake and the Star City Volunteer Fire Departments.
