



## Curtis Gregg Garland

March 14, 1955 - May 29, 2025

Gregg Garland, 70, of Point Marion, Pa., died unexpectedly Thursday, May 29, 2025, at his home. Born in Morgantown on March 14, 1955, he was a son of the late Curtis H. and Mary (Girimont) Garland.

A 1973 graduate of Morgantown High School., Gregg worked for more than 40 years at Kroger in Morgantown, retiring as grocery manager.

When his sons were young, he was very involved with sports activities in the Point Marion area, coaching T-Ball, serving on the Point Marion Park Commission, organizing the youth soccer league, and coaching soccer at the Albert Gallatin High School.
