Deon M. Evans, 55, of Point Marion, Pa., died Monday, March 10, 2014 at UPMC in Pittsburgh, following a brief illness. Born in Morgantown on May 12, 1958, he was a son of Donald Marcellus and Shirley (Bowers) Evans of Point Marion. A 1976 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, he was currently employed as a grant co-ordinator at the Human Resource Development Foundation in Morgantown. Previously, Deon was the Pastry Chef at Lakeview Country Club, the head chef at the former Barn Door Restaurant of Point Marion, and for a while taught Food Service in West Virginia. He was serving on the Board of Directors for the past several years of the Cedar Grove Cemetery in New Geneva. In addition to his loving parents, he is survived by his friend and companion, Martin Daugherty, and several cousins. He was predeceased by his brother, Brian Evans on Dec. 14, 1996.
