



## Dominic "Nick" Scafella

January 1, 1917 - May 12, 2010

Dominic "Nick" Scafella, 93, a longtime resident of Point Marion, Pa., died Saturday, May 8, 2010, in Concordia at Rebecca Residence in Allison Park, Pa. Born Feb. 2, 1917 in Marianna, Pa., he was a son of the late Carmen and Ida Delfiaco Scafella. Retired in 1989 at the age of 72 from the maintenance department of Chico Dairy in Morgantown, he had previously owned and operated for 14 years the former Stewart Dry Cleaners in Point Marion. A U.S. Navy veteran of WWII, Nick was very active in the American Legion Post 499 of Point Marion, where he served as Commander or Secretary of the Post for over 41 years.
