



## Dorothy E. Sandusky Kubicar

January 1, 1923 - June 1, 2010

Dorothy E. (Sandusky) Kubicar, 87, a longtime resident of Dilliner, Pa., died Thursday, May 27, 2010 in the Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, W.Va. Born in Dilliner on Aug. 27, 1922, she was a daughter of the late Charles and Edna Field Sandusky. A graduate of Mapletown High School, "Dot" was a faithful and active member of the Mount Pleasant United Methodist Church in Dilliner and of the United Methodist Women.
