



## Elmer J. Wolfe

January 1, 1753 - April 18, 2013

Elmer J. Wolfe, 83, formerly of Smithfield, Pa., died Friday, April 12, 2013, at the Golden Living Center in Uniontown. Born Nov. 9, 1929 in Morgantown, W.Va., he was a son of the late Charles and Thelma (Heinze) Wolfe. Elmer was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict, and served overseas for much of his four year tour of duty.
