



## Eugene Douglas Spacht

May 3, 1948 - March 17, 2012

Eugene Douglas Spacht, 63 of Gnadenuhnten, Ohio, passed away unexpectedly Monday, February 13, 2012 at Trinity Hospital Twin City in Dennison, Ohio. Born in Morgantown, West Virginia on May 3, 1948, he was raised in Monroeville, Pa., a son of Gladys Hixenbaugh Spacht of Lake Lynn, Pa., and the late Herbert Douglas Spacht.
