February 4, 1941 - March 23, 2024

Frederick "Ted" Shuppe, 83, of Dilliner, passed away Saturday, March 23, 2024, in the Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, following a brief illness. Born Feb.4, 1941 in Dilliner, he was a son of the late George and Mary (Vukovich) Shuppe.

A 1959 graduate of Mapletown High School, he was a coal miner, retired from Duquesne Light's Warwick Mine. In his retirement, Ted enjoyed cutting grass while helping with the maintenance of several local cemeteries, spending time with his buddies at the truck stop in Mount Morris, or visiting all over the Dilliner area, always with a smile on his face and a story to tell.

Surviving is his wife, Lori Shuppe and his step-children, Ben, Stacy and Elizabeth; a cherished granddaughter, Charlotte; step-granddaughter, Pearl, and a great-grandson, Christian; his sister, Melinda Williams of Dilliner; a number of nieces, nephews and cousins, many friends, and his faithful and constant furry companion, Daisy.
