



## Gaither Duane Eggers

April 5, 1936 - May 8, 2020

Gaither Duane Eggers, 84, of Hookstown, Pa., (Beaver County) formerly of the Dilliner, Pa. area, passed away Friday, May 8, 2020, at the UPMC-Presbyterian Hospital, Pittsburgh, following a brief illness. Born in Dilliner on April 5, 1936, he was a son of the late Grover C. and Mildred (Sicklesmith) Eggers.

A 1955 graduate of Mapletown High School, and a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, Duane was a retired machinist from LTV (formerly J & L) Steel Mills in Aliquippa.
