George B. "Skeeter" Rowe, 79, of Woodside, Pa., died Monday, January 19, 2026, at Peroni's Personal Care Home in Uniontown, following a lengthy illness. Born July 1, 1946 in Bobtown, Pa., he was a son of the late Carl J. and Ruth Elda (Johnson) Rowe.

A 1964 graduate of Mapletown High School, George was a retired coal miner, having worked at J & L Steel's Shannopin Mine in Bobtown, and later at Cumberland Mine in Kirby, Pa. He was a Methodist by faith, a member of the UMWA, Locals 6159 and 2300, and active with the Senior Citizens Centers in both Smithfield and Masontown. George was an avid antique car buff, having restored several antique autos, including his beautiful 1957 Chevy that many will remember, and a member of several car clubs in the area.
