George Sarapa, 85, of Dilliner (Taylortown), Pa. died quietly Friday, October 11, 2013, at the home of his son, following a lengthy illness. Born in Burgettstown, Pa. on Jan. 31, 1928, he was a son of the late Stephen Sarapa and Opal (Mathews) Sarapa Arrizano.
