Harry Henry “Hank Snow” Szczyrbak, 83, of Bobtown, Pa., died Monday, May 10, 2010, in the Monongalia General Hospital, Morgantown, W.Va. Born Jan 14, 1927 in Denbo, Pa., he was a son of the late Kazimier and Mary Kovalcheck Szczyrbak. A U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict, Henry was a coal miner, retired after 44 years employment at the Shannopin Mine in Bobtown.
