



## Ira J. Donley, Jr.

January 1, 1922 - December 15, 2010

Ira J. Donley, Jr., 88, of Dilliner, and a lifelong resident of Greene County, passed away on Thursday, December 9, 2010, in the Point Manor Personal Care Home in Point Marion. Born at Bald Hill on Dec. 6, 1922, he was a son of the late Ira and Adelia Stone Donley, Sr. A 1941 graduate of Point Marion High School, he attended the University of Alabama for two years prior to going into the military. He was a U.S. Army veteran World War II, having served from 1943 – 46. He operated Donley Trucking for a while, and then entered the coal mines, retiring as a boss for the Fort Martin Coal Company.
