Irwin Keith St.Clair, 58, of Greensboro, Pa., passed away Monday, April 29, 2019, in the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Pittsburgh, from complications of ALS. Born May 28, 1960 in Buffalo, New York, he was a son of June (Greenwood) St.Clair of Greensboro, and the late Roy E. St.Clair.

While attending Mapletown High School, he was an outstanding member of the football team. He was a veteran of the United States Army. First employed in maintenance while living in Maryland, he later became a long-distance truck driver.

Keith showed artistic ability at a very young age, and became a self-taught painter. He worked in oils and watercolors, painting scenes in nature, animals, religious subjects and portraits.

His gentle and compassionate disposition led him to become an organ donor. Through this last selfless act, others will see with his donated corneas, many burn victims will recover with skin grafts, and other ALS victims may have a chance at a longer life.

In addition to his mother, Keith is survived by one brother, Roy Allen St.Clair of Greensboro; three sisters, Penny Jenkins of Davistown, Lori Kime of Mount Morris, and Robin St.Clair of Waynesburg, as well as several nieces and

nephews.

Friends are invited to join the family for graveside services at the Garards Fort Cemetery on Saturday, May 4th, at 1:00 P.M., with Rev. James Lewis officiating. Military honors will be accorded at the graveside by the Point Marion Veterans Posts. Following the committal, a brief service and reception will be held at the Fordyce United Methodist Church.
