Jack O. Daugherty, 86, of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Thursday, March 25, 2021, at his son's home in McClellandtown. Born in Lake Lynn on Dec. 9, 1934, he was a son of the late Willis and Carmen (Kennedy) Daugherty.

A 1953 graduate of Point Marion High School, he was a veteran of the U.S. Army. Jack was an appliance repairman, and later employed with State Electronics in both Uniontown and Morgantown as salesclerk and office manager.

Surviving are his three sons and their wives, John and Donna Daugherty of Chesapeake, VA, Larry and Anita Daugherty of McClellandtown, David and Jennifer Daugherty of Smithfield; two daughters, Trena Daugherty and her partner Kim Davis of Durham, NC, and Lisa Daugherty and her fiancé Guy Pellegrini of Finleyville, Pa.; ten grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

His wife, Mary Louise (McCartney) Daugherty passed away on Jan. 29, 2006. Jack was the last of his immediate family, having been preceded in death by four brothers, Erwin, Ray and Robert Daugherty and Delmar in infancy; and two sisters Sara Drew and Leora Ganoë.
