James Keith “Jim” Everly, 84, of Dilliner (Bald Hill), Pa., passed away Thursday, October 15, 2015 in the Golden Living Center in Morgantown. He leaves behind his companion of 23 years, Diane Wade.

Jim was predeceased in death by his mother, Catherine (Lewellen) Everly Frum; father, Oren O’neil Everly; a sister, Gloria (Everly) Rupert Johnson; and a brother, Peter O’neil Everly.
