March 26, 1947 - January 23, 2022

John David Haynie, 74, of Morgantown, and formerly of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Sunday, January 23, 2022 at his home with his family at his side, following a lengthy illness. Born in Waynesburg, Pa. on March 26, 1947, he was a son of the late John C. and Candida (Gasbarre) Haynie.

A 1966 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, David served with the U.S. Marine Corps during the Vietnam Conflict. He received the Purple Heart and the Vietnam Service Medal with three stars, in addition to a number of other commendations and medals. After his discharge from the Marines, he worked in the coal mines at the Shannopin and Cumberland Mines, and then retiring a ramp attendant for TWA in Washington, D.C.

David was a man of strong faith, and a devoted member of the Oak Grove Church of Christ in Lake Lynn. He served there as Deacon, as attended several mission trips to Mexico sponsored by the church. As a member of the V.F.W. Post 747, and the American Legion, Post 499, both in Point Marion, he was always willing to assist his fellow veterans, or lend a hand to anyone else needing his help.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Eileen (Szerensci) Haynie; a son, Mark Haynie of Amity, Pa., two daughters and their husbands, Robin and Wendell O'Hern, III of Savannah, GA, and Rebekah and Thomas Young of Amity; eight

grandchildren, Cailin, Jacob, Lauren and Eliana O'Hern, and Anna, Lena, Joel and Evan Young; one brother Tom Haynie and wife Susan of St. George, Utah, one sister, Susan Benarick and husband Glen of Aiken, SC.; and a sister-in-law, Marlene Brown and husband Doug, of Smithfield, and their family

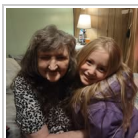
