



## Joseph Buffalo

January 1, 1753 - October 9, 2010

Joseph Buffalo, 80, of Point Marion, Pa., died Wednesday, October 6, 2010, in the Monongalia General Hospital, Morgantown, West Virginia, with his loving wife at his side. Born Feb. 24, 1930 in Burke, W.Va., he was a son of the late Joseph and Amelia Buffalo. A U.S. Marine Corps veteran of the Korean War, Joe was a coal miner, retired from Duquesne Light, a member of the UMWA, Local 6310, and of the Redeemed Baptist Church in Point Marion. Surviving are his wife of 56 years, Ida Mae (Lorenz) Buffalo; his devoted daughter, Margaret A. Burns of Masontown, Pa.; a beloved granddaughter, Erica Burns of Pittsburgh; and by several nieces and nephews. He was the last of his immediate family, having been predeceased by brothers, Big Joe, Andy and Reno; and sisters, Edith, Lena, his twin sister, Josephine "Tootsie" and Gladys. Friends will be received in the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, Point Marion on Thursday from 7 – 9 p.m., Friday from 2 - 4 and 7 – 9 p.m., and Saturday, October 9, 2010, until 11:00 A.M., the hour of service, with Rev. French Jenkins officiating. Interment follows in Evergreen Memorial Park, Point Marion, with military rites accorded at the graveside by the V.F.W. Post 747, and the American Legion, Post 499, both of Point Marion.
