Judith Ann "Judy" Hall, 70, of Dilliner, Pa., died Friday, May 21, 2010 in the Monongalia General Hospital, Morgantown, W.Va., following a courageous battle with cancer. Born in Point Marion, Pa. on Feb. 23, 1940, she was a daughter of the late Alfred "Jake" and Wanda Grow Stewart. A faithful and active member of the Mount Pleasant United Methodist Church in Dilliner and of the United Methodist Women, she had formerly been employed for 20 years as a licensed practical nurse at the West Virginia University Hospital.
