Keith R. Drew, 69, of Mapletown, Pa., passed away Sunday, December 6, 2020, at the Mon Health Medical Center in Morgantown, following a brief illness. Born in Waynesburg on Oct. 3, 1951, he was a son of the late Harry E. and Dorothy (Miller) Drew.

A 1969 graduate of Mapletown High School, he also received an Associate's Degree in drafting from Penn State at the Fayette Campus. Keith was a coal miner for 35 years, retiring in 2011 from Alpha Resources' Cumberland Mine. He was a member of the U.M.W.A. Local 6321, and the Mapletown United Methodist Church, where he was chairman of the Pastor/Parish Relations Committee, and serving on the Board of Trustees.

For many years, Keith has been active with the Greensboro Vol. Fire Dept., and was currently serving as President of the Department, in addition to being the EMS coordinator for Monongahela Township.

He is survived by his wife of 48 years, Susan (Wilson) Drew; three daughters and their husbands, Karen Smith and Erik of Greensboro, Sharon Moraski and Jim of Columbiana, Ohio, and Krissy Shultz and Shawn of Concord, North Carolina; seven grandchildren, Kayla and Kelsi Smith, Cale and Marissa Moraski and Skylar, Chase and Raegan Shultz; two brothers and their wives, Harry A. and Rebecca Drew and Gary and Joyce Drew, all of Greensboro,

and their families.

Friends will be received in the Mapletown United Methodist Church (formerly the Holy Family R.C. Church) in Greensboro on Thursday from 3 – 8 PM, and Friday from 10 until the 11:00 AM hour of service, with Pastors Lanfer Simpson and Kenneth Haines officiating. Interment follows in Monongahela Hill Cemetery, Greensboro, Pa. CDC recommendations will be observed in the hall during the visitation and funeral service. Arrangements are in the care of the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home.

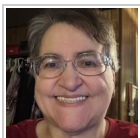
