



## Kenneth John DuBois

January 19, 1960 - March 9, 2015

Kenneth J. DuBois, 55, of Fairmont, W.Va., and formerly of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Monday, March 9, 2015 in the Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown. Born Jan. 19, 1960 in New Kensington, Pa., he was the son of Mary Lou (Stewart) and Alfred E. DuBois, Sr., of Point Marion.

A 1978 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, he was raised in St. Hubert's R.C. Church, where he had been an altar server. He was currently employed as an Inventory Control Analyst at Ruby Memorial Hospital, where he has worked for the past 31 years.

Over the years, he has been active in the Boy Scouts, the Knights of Columbus, and with the Volunteer Fire Department, all in Point Marion.
