Kenneth E. Jackson, 74, of Dilliner (Taylortown), Pa., passed away Wednesday, April 14, 2021, at the Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, following a brief illness. Born in Dilliner on August 24, 1946, he was a son of the late Ray and Helen Jean (McClain) Jackson.
