



## Larry Cralton

September 2, 1942 - March 21, 2021

Larry Cralton, 78, of Bobtown, Pa., died Sunday, March 21, 2021, at his home, following a brief illness. Born Sept. 2, 1942 in Mount Morris, Pa., he was a son of the late Floyd and Margaret (Hustead) Cralton.

Larry was an evangelist, and the assistant pastor at the Healing Wings Outreach Church in Taylortown, and had retired as a certified pipefitter and welder.
