Larry A. Lambert, 66, of Masontown, Pa., died unexpectedly Friday, May 30, 2025 at the Uniontown Hospital. Born in Morgantown on Dec. 8, 1958, he was a son of the late Ella M. (Smitley) and Brinley O. Lambert, Sr.
