Larry P. Marks, 74, of Farmington, Pa., passed away Saturday, January 27, 2024, in the Uniontown Hospital, following a courageous two year battle with cancer. Born Feb. 22, 1949 in Pittsburgh, Pa., he was a son of the late Edwin and Sarah Hogsett Marks.

A 1968 graduate of Uniontown High School, he retired from Kennemetal Inc. as a senior computer analysis and project manager, and had previously worked for Jessop Steel in Washington, Pa. He also enjoyed working with his hands which is evident in the house he built, the gardens he grew and the art he created.

Larry was first and foremost a devoted servant to his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He proved this by using the gifts God gave him in the church. He was a member of Wharton Furnace Union Church and served in several capacities including President of the Board.
