



## Leona Reed Eberhart

January 17, 1928 - October 22, 2020

Leona Hoone Reed Eberhart, 92, of Point Marion, passed away Thursday, October 22, 2020, surrounded by her loving family.

Leona was born on January 17, 1928, in Smithfield, Pa., a daughter of the late Charles and Mary (Miller) Hoone. As a young woman, she could often be found helping her dad in the homestead coal mine, or out dancing the polka. For someone who never drove a car, she was always hard to catch at home!

Better known as “Granny” by those who loved her, Leona left a bit of sparkle everywhere she went. She loved long phone calls, front porch sittin’, anything with a cardinal on it, and saying exactly what was on her mind. You could crack any joke at Granny’s house (her sons-in-law, especially, often did!), and she’d dish it right back at you. Her pantry was always stocked with Fritos, gobs, and Reese’s cups, and she was happy to fix you a sandwich – even if you’d just had lunch.

The empty seat at Granny’s kitchen table will be sorely missed by her children: Leah (Linda), Luann Garlick, Donna (Henry) McClain, Bill (Peggy) Reed, Cindy Frankenberry, Eugene (Lisa), Ronald (Elizabeth), George (Vicki), Sandy (Chad) Martin, and Janie (Andy) Bohan, her 29 grandchildren, her 29 great-grandchildren, and her eight great-great grandchildren, and many others.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Harold “Bee” Eberhart, who she married on April 25, 1959, her sister Laura (Hoone) Takacs and brothers, Bill, Bob and Leo Hoone, her son Buck Reed, her sons-in-law Ron Garlick, Ron Frankenberry, and Jim Reynolds, and her grandson Henry McClain.

We will celebrate Granny’s life with one last “who!” on Monday, October 26, 2020. Her funeral service will be in the care of the Richard R.
