Lois (South) Burwell, 88, of Dilliner (Taylortown), Pa. passed away Thursday, April 26, 2012, at her home. Born in Atoka, Oklahoma on Dec. 4, 1923, she was a daughter of the late Clyde C. and Nelle (Conn) South. A 1941 graduate of Point Marion High School, she had been employed as a secretary for Dunkard Township Schools.
