Mike “Max” Terlesky, 91, of Newtown, Dilliner, Pa., died Monday, December 20, 2010, in the Coville Personal Care Home, Masontown, Pa. Born Sept. 5, 1919 in Moran, Clearfield County, Pa., he was the son of the late Maximillian and Sophia Bartosh Terlesky. A U.S. Army veteran of WWII, he was a coal miner, retired in 1980 after 44 years employment at J & L Steel’s Shannopin Mine in Bobtown. He was a member of St. Ignatius R.C. Church, the U.M.W.A. Local 6159, and the V.F.W. Post 5567, all in Bobtown, and the American Legion, Post 992 in Mount Morris, Pa.
