



Nancy I. Davis

November 5, 1935 - June 6, 2016

Nancy I. (Everly) Davis, Ed.D., 80, of Waynesburg, Pa., and formerly of Bald Hill, Pa., passed away Monday, June 6, 2016, in the Monongalia General Hospital, Morgantown, following recent surgery. Born at Bald Hill, (Greene County) on Nov. 5, 1935, she was a daughter of the late Oren O'neil Everly and Catherine (Lewellen) Everly Frum.

A 1953 graduate of Point Marion High School, Nancy spent her entire career in education. She was a graduate in Elementary Education from California State College, and received her Masters Degree, Administration Papers, and her Doctorate in Education from West Virginia University.

She began teaching in Mount Morris at the Perry Township School in 1965, and through the years, became the Elementary and Secondary School Principal, District Director of Curriculum, Assistant Superintendent and then Superintendent of the Central Greene School District, leaving there in 1990. For the next four years, she served as the Superintendent of Lake-Lehman School District in Dallas, Pa. Following that, she was a Visiting Assistant Professor at Wilkes University, assisted with the Off-Campus Program for Gannon University, Graduate Education Consultant for Waynesburg College, and was the Coordinator for the Greene County Education Center of the Westmoreland County Community College, where she was currently the Workforce Development Coordinator. Throughout her career, she was

involved in many professional organizations and programs, and received a number of awards and honors.

Nancy was also very active in her community, having served as Charter Member and Past President of the United Way of Greene County, Member and Past-President of the Waynesburg Rotary Club where she is also a Paul Harris Fellow, Board Member and former Chairperson of the Community Foundation of Greene County, served four terms on the Waynesburg Chamber of Commerce and received their Distinguished Service Award, and Past-President of the Greene County Chapter of the PA Association of Retired School Personnel.

In addition, she supported her husband in his ministry, and was a member and active over the years in the First Baptist Church of Dunkard, the Sugar Grove Baptist Church, near Greensboro, and finally in the First Baptist Church of Waynesburg.

Her husband of 62 years, Rev. William H. Davis, passed away on January 23, 2016. Also deceased, is her son, William Harry Davis, Jr.; a sister, Gloria (Everly) Ruppert Johnson, and two brothers, Peter O'neil Everly and James Keith Everly.

Surviving are several loving nieces and nephews, and many, many friends and colleagues.

Friends will be received in the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, 501 Morgantown St., Point Marion, on Thursday from 3 – 7 P.M., and Friday from 10 until 11:00 A.M., the hour of service, with Rev. Dr. Edward Peirce officiating. Interment follows in Cedar Grove Cemetery, Mount Morris, Pa.
