Nancy Lea Travis, 84, a lifelong resident of Point Marion, passed away peacefully Sunday, January 26, 2025, in the MonHealth Medical Center in Morgantown. Born at home in Point Marion on Nov. 16, 1940, she was a daughter of the late Gladys (Menear) and Grover Cleveland Travis.

A 1959 graduate of Point Marion High School, she trained to become a licensed practical nurse, retiring in 1987 from the Pediatric Department of Ruby Memorial Hospital. Nancy was a faithful member for many years of the First Baptist Church of Point Marion.
