Ralph W. "Babo" Bate, 84, of Dilliner, (Moffitt-Sterling), Pa., passed away Friday, September 11, 2020, in the Washington Hospital. Born in Moffitt on April 7, 1936, he was a son of the late Thomas Bate and Eleanor (Hilpert) Bate Rawlings.

A U.S. Air Force veteran of the Korean Conflict, he had worked at Penco Products of Oaks, Pa., Gateway Coal Company of Greene County until it was closed, and then in the Maintenance Department of West Virginia University.
