



Ralph E. Ganoë

January 1, 1753 - July 28, 2011

Ralph E. Ganoë, 85, a lifelong resident of Point Marion, Pa., passed away Monday, July 25, 2011 at his home, with his loving family at his side. Born Aug. 6, 1925 in Point Marion, he was a son of the late Harry and Virginia Campbell Ganoë. A 1943 graduate of Point Marion High School, he served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. After the war, Ralph graduated in 1947 from the Horological Institute of Pittsburgh (Watchmaker's School), and for the next 56 years, owned and operated Ganoë's Jewelers in Point Marion. His skill in watch repair was known throughout the area. Ralph was very active in the Point Marion Community, being a member of the Christian Church, the Chamber of Commerce, Life Member of the V.F.W. Post 747, and a member of the Point Marion Volunteer Fire Department for 58 years, where he served several terms as President, and was Chief of the Department for 12 years. He was also a member of the F & AM Valley Lodge 459 in Masontown. Surviving are his three children and their spouses, Gary and Linda Ganoë and Ellen and Dennis Smith, all of Point Marion, and Greg and Janine Ganoë of Morgantown, W.Va., four grandchildren, Jeremy and Jason Ganoë and Damon and Mallory Hartley, and four great-grandchildren, Derek and Zachary Ganoë, Alex Hartley and Kayla Campbell. His wife of 57 years, Leora R. (Daugherty) Ganoë passed away on Oct. 27, 2007. Also deceased is a brother, William Ganoë. Friends will be received in the Richard R. Herod Funeral Home, Point Marion, on Wednesday from 2 - 4 and 6 - 9 p.m., and Thursday until 11:00 a.m., the hour of service, with Rev. French Jenkins

officiating. Interment follows in Evergreen Memorial Park, Point Marion. Point Marion Volunteer Fire Department will hold services Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. in the funeral home.
