



## Ralph F. Stewart

October 15, 1956 - January 22, 2015

Ralph F. Stewart, 58, died unexpectedly Thursday, January 22, 2015, at the Ruby Memorial Hospital in Morgantown. Born in Morgantown on Oct. 15, 1956, he was a son of the late Lawrence and Ruth (Wertz) Stewart.

A 1974 graduate of Albert Gallatin High School, he retired after 33 years employment with PennDOT. 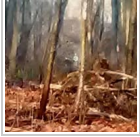
